Our "Good Wood" Project (at the Park City center) is the only program of its kind in Utah! Our main source of revenue is the generosity of our members.

RU works with and educates the community to conserve natural re- sources, especially water, energy & landfill space. * RU collects an average of 25 tons of glass per month! * RU collected approx. 47,500 lbs of hazardous materials. * Newspaper bin - also accepts magazines, brochures, brown paper bags & phone books. We also recycle alkaline batteries, moving boxes, Styrofoam pea- nuts, bubble wrap, cellular phones, mercury thermometers, VHS tapes and any clean plastic bags.
