### Recycle Utah’s Mission is to Empower People to Lead Sustainable Lives.™

In 1991, a group of concerned citizens established the Park City Conservation Association which operates as Recycle Utah to collect recycling, promote water conservation, and envision a zero-waste plan for Summit County, Utah.

- Recycle Utah prevents 200 tons of recyclables from being landfilled every month.
- Recycle Utah accepts 40 different items from households and businesses and maintains satellite collection locations in Kimball Junction, Oakley, Kamas and Heber.
- Environmental teachers visit 4,000 school children in classrooms every year.
- Recycle Utah serves about 80,000 people in Summit and Wasatch Counties.

### Recycling Tips

Look for the recycling symbol on or near the bottom of plastic containers:



Plastic #1- pop bottles, water bottles, etc.



Plastic #2- milk jugs, etc. (Foggy only)

If you see no symbol, plastic can be recycled as “mixed plastic“ #2-7.



The recycling symbol with a percentage inside indicates the percentage of recycled content in a product such as paper or cardboard.

- Collected at the Three Mile Canyon Landfill, Monday –Saturday 8am-4pm. Call 435.615.3970 or 435.336.3970 for more information
- Don’t flush those meds! Drop them off instead at the Park City Police Station on Park Avenue. The drop-off box is available 24/7, just inside the building.
- We also hold an Annual Household Hazardous Waste Collection Event in May at The Canyons Parking Lot. (Check [www.recycleutah.org](http://www.recycleutah.org) for date & details)

### Materials Accepted at Other Recycle Utah Locations

- Kimball Junction (WalMart parking lot): mixed paper & aluminum cans
- Kamas (behind Summit County Search & Rescue): mixed paper & aluminum cans
- Oakley (next to City Hall): mixed paper, any color glass & aluminum cans
- Heber City (Smith’s Food parking lot): mixed paper

# MATERIALS ACCEPTED at the Woodbine Way Center

## Outside Bins

- Aluminum cans
- Corrugated cardboard, paperboard, waxed cartons with plastic removed
- Glass: clear, green, brown, blue
- Mixed metal, steel/tin cans, foil-lined bags such as coffee bags
- Mixed paper — newspaper, magazines, catalogues, phone books, books, paper bags and “any paper that comes in the mail”
- Tetra Pacs (foil-lined containers with plastic caps removed)
- White & pastel office paper

## Plastics Tent

*Please rinse and crush all plastics, and remove caps which are recycled separately. Please, NO food residue, NO metal, NO styrofoam, NO rubber.*

- **Plastic bags** — grocery bags, clean inner bags from cereal & cracker boxes, other plastic bags
- **#1 PETE** plastics such as transparent soda, juice & water bottles
- **#2 HDPE** opaque plastics (milk jugs, water jugs) please, no solid colored plastics
- **#2—#7 Colored & Mixed Plastics**
- Large plastic items such as lawn chairs, buckets, bins, etc. are accepted in the baling bay (see staff for details). NO PVC pipe in this bag

## EPS Packing Foam Collection

**EPS Foam Blocks.** No food residue in containers or cups. Foam will be densified to reduce volume. White blocks of clean foam only. It will be densified to reduce volume. Packing peanuts are accepted inside the office.

## Moving Boxes & Packing Materials Reuse Program

Donate your moving boxes, bubble wrap, packing peanuts, and packing paper for others to purchase at a great price.

## E-Waste Collection Daily (Located in The Warehouse)

- TVs, microwaves, computers, keyboards, CPUs, printers, laptops, any electronics. We charge a nominal fee to process these items.

## Items Accepted Outside: May – October

- Bike tubes & tires
- Planter pots (plastic), all sizes
- Tennis & running shoes
- Child car seats
- Wooden pallets

- Energy bar wrappers (all brands)
- Drink pouch containers
- Frito Lay brand chip wrappers

## Inside Bins (Inside Our Office):

Recycle your alkaline batteries, rechargeable batteries (Ni-Cad, Ni-Mh, Li-ion, or Pb), empty ink & toner cartridges, cellular telephones, pagers, PDAs, iPods, CDs, jewel cases, Tyvek envelopes.

Please, NO car batteries!

## Mercury-Containing Items

CFLs, light tubes, mercury thermometers & thermostats.
