### HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS MATERIALS

#### FREE DROP-OFF INFORMATION:

- Collected at the Summit County Landfill, Three Mile Canyon
- Collected at Recycle Utah's bi-annual Household Hazardous Waste Collections in May and October at Canyons parking lot

#### MATERIALS ACCEPTED:

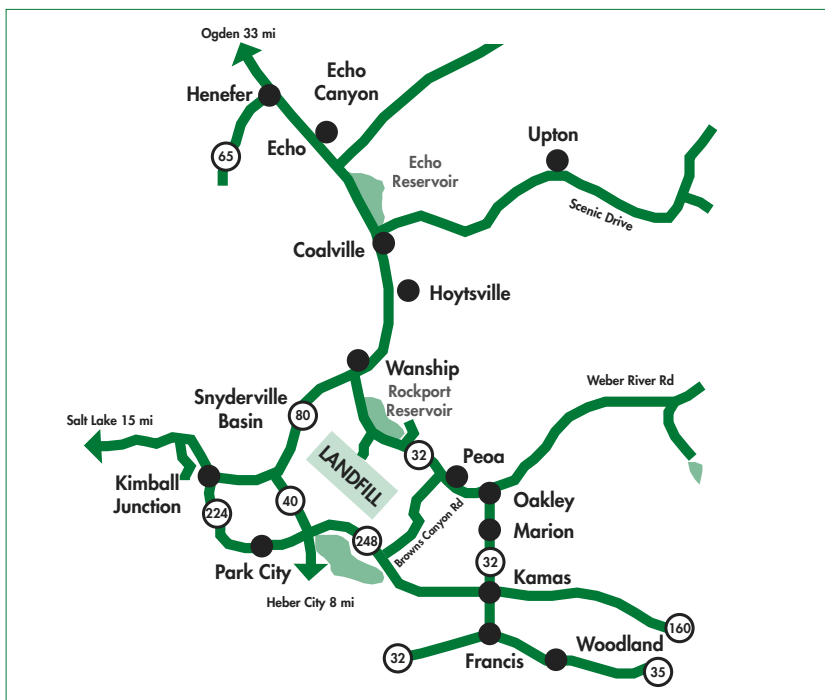
- Paints, solvents, and woodworking supplies, including finishes, thinners, strippers, and stains
- Automotive products including antifreeze, used oil, brake and transmission fluid, car batteries, gasoline, diesel and fuel additives, solvents, and degreasers
- Household cleaners with high bleach or abrasive content, polishes, drain openers, and oven cleaners
- Fertilizers, pesticides, herbicides, and insect repellents
- All types of batteries
- Pool and spa chemicals
- Mercury-containing items including switches, thermostats, thermometers, and smoke detectors
- Propane and white gas fuel cylinders
- Film developing chemicals and acids
- Compact fluorescent light bulbs (CFLs)
- Refrigerators, any size (\$12 recycling fee)

### SUMMIT COUNTY LANDFILL, THREE MILE CANYON

#### HOW TO GET THERE:

Take the Wanship Exit off of Interstate 80 onto Route 32. Proceed south 3.5 miles. The landfill entrance is opposite the Rockport Reservoir. Look for a street sign that says "Three Mile Canyon Road."

### ELECTRONIC WASTE

Electronic waste is accepted Monday - Saturday, 8 AM - 5 PM, at the **Summit County Landfill** and at **Recycle Utah** in Park City. Fees apply. Accepted items include cell phones, pagers, PDAs, iPods, computers, CPUs, keyboards, scanners, stereos, televisions, monitors, and laptops.
